To be located between West Winnebago Street, North 6th Street and McKinley Avenue. 55,000 square feet, including two full sized courts, weight room, hydrotherapy and medical training area, player and coaches' locker room, video replay theater, full-service kitchen, dining area, storage and secure parking.

Block 7 Parking Structure

Six-tiered, multi-function parking structure building with a minimum of 1,243 parking spaces. Will include mixed-use components including approximately 10,000 square feet along the south side of the building on Juneau Avenue and 11,000 square feet along the north side on McKinley Avenue. The mixed-use spaces will be designed as core and shell spaces and will be incorporated into the structure of the parking garage providing for fire separation, ventilation, and all code requirements. The master design will accommodate space along North 6th Street for approximately 1000,000 Square Feet of apartment units. The residential components is not included in this project.

Proposed Construction Start and End Dates: June 2016 – October 2017

- 18% professional services spending with DBE, SBE, SDB, and/or 8(a).
- 40% of the on-site construction hours to be performed by residents meeting the City of Milwaukee's Residents Preference Program.
- 25% of the on-site construction trade labor hours to be performed by residents of Milwaukee County.
- 15% of the on-site construction trade labor hours to be performed by apprentices or member of acceptable
 job training programs.
- Prevailing wages must be paid to each worker performing construction trade labor on the project.

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New Milwaukee Bucks Arena

700,000 Square Feet multi-purpose sports and entertainment center located on 6.7 acres immediately north of the BMO Harris Bradley Center. A portion of the 4th Street adjacent to the New Arena between Highland and Juneau Avenues will serve as the entrance plaza. 17,500 fans for basketball games.

Proposed Construction Start and End Dates: July 2016-August 2018

Requirements:

- 25% construction spending with DBE, SBE, SDB and/or 8(a).
- 18% professional service spending with DBE, SBE, SDB, and/or 8(a).
- 40% of the on-site construction hours to be performed by residents meeting the City of Milwaukee's Resident Preference Program requirements.
- Will be designed and constructed to achieve minimum LEED certification.
- Living wages must be paid to each worker performing construction trade labor on the project.
